Vehicle Noise Pollution and Parking Restrictions

Policy:

Excessively loud and/or vulgar music coming from your car, your room or from a device in your possession will not be tolerated. The discretion of the investigating officer will determine what is excessive, and reasonable standards will be applied. However, as a matter of common courtesy, music should only be played loud enough for your personal enjoyment without infringing upon the rights of others. **Everyone who operates a vehicle on campus must purchase a parking permit.**

You must have a valid driver's license and show proof of insurance to purchase a decal. Parking or operating a vehicle on campus without a valid decal may result in a citation, a vehicle boot or your vehicle being towed at your expense.

No Parking Zones

- Do not park, drive or walk on the grass.
- Do not park in a handicap space without a valid handicap sticker. You must also be prepared and able to verify that the sticker belongs to either you or your passenger.
- Do not park where the curb is painted yellow.
