RV Park Rules and Regulations

Policy:

- There is a 3 ½ foot “Fire Lane” which is located at the end of every RV Pad and all the way down every street between pads using crushed limestone (see illustration below). Vehicles, bicycles, golf-carts, chairs, BBQ Grills, tents, or any other personal items are not allowed in this Fire Lane area which includes the area with crushed stone.
- Please avoid parking cars, bicycles, golf-carts, or other motorized vehicles on the grass.
- Our Sewer Dump Station is located next to the sewer lift-station in the parking lot at the corner of the stadium.
- Advanced purchased RV permit(s) will have assigned reserved space number indicated. This is the ONLY authorized parking slot.
- RV parking will be allowed only in designated areas. RVs must park according to lot design (Overflow parking will be designated once RV Park is filled).
- All RV lot patrons must display the appropriate pass for access and parking. Vehicles not displaying the appropriate pass will be required to purchase a permit onsite.
- RV Park spaces will be filled before overflow or grass parking is allowed. Reserved RV spaces are not guaranteed until FULL payment is received by the required deadline date. Payments can be made by cash, check, or credit card.
- RVers are allowed ONE (1) tow (car/truck/trailer (grill or golf cart)) or accompanying vehicle per RV space with the appropriate pass. No unauthorized vehicles (delivery or visiting) will be allowed into RV Park after 10:00 p.m. the day prior to game.
- In cases where the RV and tow exceeds the space allotted, the tow will be required to park in a different location in close proximity to the RV Park.

- Recreational ATV/UTV Mopeds, scooters, ATVs, UTVs, go carts and other custom gas/diesel motorized vehicles are not permitted on the ASU campus. Golf Carts are the ONLY allowed authorized recreational vehicles within the events area (RV, tailgating or parking zones). No one under the age of sixteen (16) shall operate a golf cart or motorized vehicle on ASU campus.
- The RV must be confined to one RV space per the assigned slot. Tow vehicle space will be within your RV space. Amenities such as awnings, grills, and furniture must be utilized within allotted space. Do not facilitate large gatherings that may infringe upon the rights and space of others.
- Care must be taken to prevent levelers from damaging the paved surface of your space. You must place plywood or any other flat material that is sturdy, of sufficient thickness and sufficient size under levelers in order to distribute the weight over enough area to prevent damage to the paved surface.
- Tent camping or camping in tow vehicles, pickup trucks, or vehicles not designated as RVs is prohibited.
- RVs must be removed from the campus no later than 2:00 p.m. on the day after each home game (Unless prior authorization has been granted).
- RV parking will be available two days before game day. Early parking may be authorized with advance coordination. An additional fee of \$35.00 per day applies for earlier arrivals and later departures.
- MUSIC must be confined to your tailgate area and speakers must be directed into your tailgate party. All music must be in good taste and appropriate for all ages (infant to seniors). ASU reserves the right to terminate any music that is deemed inappropriate.
- A quiet period from midnight to 6 a.m. will be enforced.
- Pets are not allowed to run free in tailgating sites, they must be leashed and kept within the confines of the RV space or remain in the RV. Furthermore, animals shall not be left unattended or secured to university property (poles or tree). Please clean up after your pet.
- Authorized ASU personnel and the ASU Campus Police will monitor all tailgating areas to enforce tailgating guidelines.
- All units must have an exhaust stack that extends above the RV if tailgaters plan to run a gas/diesel powered built-in generator.
- DO NOT anchor awning, tents, or canopies by use of spikes or stakes in paved areas. The use of stakes may result in the loss of RV lot privileges and fines and bills for any damages and repairs.
- Please dispose of your waste properly. It is important that the campus is returned to its pristine state after each event. To achieve this, we ask that you please bag your trash and place it in the authorized commercial container. RVers are asked to dispose of all trash and debris responsibly. RVers should properly extinguish grills, coals, ashes and other potential flammable materials. RVers should leave the site in a clean condition. DO NOT leave or dump charcoal, wood or grease in the trash cans, grass, shrubs, parking lots or the street drains. ASU reserves the right to revoke privileges of violators.

- The dumping of untreated waste water is in violation of local, state and federal law and is subject to fines and criminal prosecution. Violators will lose their RV privilege – no refund will be provided.
