ALCORN STATE UNIVERSITY HOUSING CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This is a Legal and Binding Contract between the University and Student

Contract Period

A. The period of this contract is for an entire academic year, both fall and spring terms. If the student contracts after the beginning of the semester, the charges will begin on the date of Application Submission.

Termination of Contract by the Student

- A. Before the lease has become binding, a student may cancel the lease by providing written notice to the Department of Residence Life if postmarked 30 days prior to the first day of the fall semester.
- B. The lease may be canceled if the student demonstrates meeting one of the following criterions: unanticipated financial hardship ensuing after the start of the semester; medical reasons that are documented by a physician; academic internship or student teaching experience more than 40 Miles from ASU; employment requiring live-in status; A change in marital or custodial status.

Termination of the Contract by the University

The University may terminate this contract and require the student to vacate the residence hall for, but not limited to, the following reasons:

- 1. Failure to meet financial obligations to the University.
- 2. Official University disciplinary actions.
- 3. Violation of the terms of this contract.

Food Service

All meals and Flex dollars are reset at the start of each semester and do not roll over from semester to semester. Meal plans cannot be changed after registration is complete. All on campus students MUST have a meal plan.

Right of Entry

The University, its officers, mployees, and agents shall have the right to enter assigned rooms at reasonable times for the purpose of inspection, repair, preservation of health, safety, quietude, recovery of Alcorn owned property, and for suspected policy violations.

Changes in Assignments

- A. The University will not discriminate in room assignments on the basis of race, creed, religion, national origin, or disability.
- B. Room assignments will be made at the discretion of the University on the basis of the date the lease and \$125 deposit fee is received by the Department of Residence Life. Whenever possible, individual room assignment requests will be honored.
- C. The University reserves the right to change room or hall assignments for health, safety, repair services, economy or disciplinary reasons involving the resident, or for unresolvable incompatibility of roommates.
- D. The University reserves the right to consolidate vacancies by requiring any resident to move from a single occupancy of double rooms to double rooms.
- E. The resident must vacate his/her assigned room at the closing times established by Alcorn at the end of each semester and the beginning of each vacation break period.
- F. The resident may NOT change room assignments without receiving the appropriate paperwork from Department of Residence Life.

Prohibitions

- A. For health and safety reasons, the following are not permitted in the residence halls: space heaters, air conditioners, waterbeds, fireworks, firearms or ammunition weapons of any kind, explosives, possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages, possession and/or use of illegal drugs, candles, incense, anything with an open flame, hot plates, sun lamps, multiple socket plugs, and any appliances with an open heating coil.
- B. Pets are not permitted in or around the residence halls. Guests may not bring any type of pet while visiting a resident.
- C. Use of tobacco is prohibited.
