Thank you for your interest in Alcorn State University (ASU) School of Nursing. Our RN to BSN track caters to licensed registered nurses who graduated from an associate degree or diploma program and want to pursue a BSN degree ONLINE over a 2 SEMESTER time frame.

Requirements for admission to the RN to BSN Option are as outlined in the specific criteria and requirements below.

ADMISSION CRITERIA AND REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RN TO BSN PROGRAM OPTION

The applicant must:

1. A copy of a current unencumbered registered nurse (RN) license.
2. Be eligible for undergraduate admission to Alcorn State University;
3. Submit an official high school transcript or documentation of GED;
4. Submit official transcript(s) from each college/university attended (The official transcripts from every college or university attended must reflect grades posted through Spring 2021);
5. Must also have at least a grade of C in each prerequisite course and an overall grade point average of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale;
6. Have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale on transferable college credits;
7. Complete an Alcorn State University Application for Undergraduate Admission;
8. Complete an Application for Admission to Undergraduate Nursing Programs; and
9. Complete lower level prerequisites for entering to the upper level program of study. Lower level prerequisites must be completed and documented (via transcript) by each applicant prior to the anticipated date of enrollment in the first clinical nursing course (The application may be submitted pending completion of the prerequisite courses.)
10. 2 Letters of Recommendations (2) Supervision, Academic or Community Service Letters
11. Resume
12. Personal Statement

In addition, the application process for the University requires submission of:

1. a copy of your immunization record

Alcorn State University's School of Nursing has a very competitive selection process. Selections for program admission are based on a rating scale that is completed for each qualified applicant. Qualified applicants with complete files are ranked from highest to lowest based on the points reflected on the RN to BSN Selection Sheets (attached). Program selection begins with those applicants who have the highest number of total points and continues until all available seats are filled.
