(1) An acknowledgement that the institution signed and returned to the Department the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution has used the applicable amount of funds designated under the ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students	The American Rescue Plan (ARP) included additional COVID-19 relief for institutions of higher education. This new COVID stimulus bill included \$40 billion, available through September 30, 2023, for higher education institutions and students, using the same Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) model established in the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act. ASU acknowledges that the University signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement under the CARES Act and therefore are not required to complete additional applications or forms. The ARP HEERF III funds require that 50% of an ASU institution's funds be spent on student grants.
(2) The total amount of funds that the institution will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under the ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs	The total amount of HEERF III funds that ASU received from ED is \$15,634,269. ASU must provide grants to eligible students at least 50% of allocation. The amount allocated for the student portion of HEERF III is \$7,925,802.

HEERF III Grant funds distributed to students: July - September 2021 (Third Quarterly Report) \$26,550 as of June 30, 2021

(6) The method(s) used by the institution to determine which students receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants and how much they would receive under the ARP (a)(1) and (a)(4) programs.	ASU based prioritization of students with exceptional need, such as students who receive Pell grants but not limited to student who receive Pell grants. Eligibility for funds is based on a student's Estimated Family Contribution (EFC). The highest aid awards will be available to students with zero EFC; the smallest allocations will be available to students with a higher EFC.
(7) Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided by the institution to students concerning the Emergency Financial Aid Grants	Additional guidance for HEERF II grants: University will send an email to current enrolled fall students. Eligible students will be awarded according to above criteria. Once students have been deemed eligible, Bursar and Accounting will be notified to disburse funds.
