We are writing to share information about the Frederick Douglass Global Fellowship, a full scholarship to study abroad with a cohort of student leaders from around the country. The fellowship is sponsored by the Council on International Educational Exchange (or CIEE), a non-profit student exchange organization whom we partner with.

The mission of the Frederick Douglass Global Fellowship is to empower students of color with a transformative experience abroad, much like Douglass was inspired by his travels. It covers all program fees and travel costs for a customized summer study abroad program, focused on key intercultural frameworks and leadership practices.

To celebrate the 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Douglass's first trip abroad, Ireland's Department of Foreign Affairs is co-sponsoring the next class of Fellows. You'll be based in Dublin, but visit other cities where Douglass campaigned against slavery, while meeting with government leaders, and social justice activists.
