

Documents Needed To Begin Study Abroad Process

1. Go to the Office of Global Programs website and download the Study Abroad Application to your hard drive. It can be filled out and saved with entered information using the free Adobe Reader. Here is the link to the Study Abroad application. Second link is for these instructions.

2. When the application is filled out with the necessary information, please get the following:
 - a. A copy of your transcript as downloaded from Banner (not the official registrar's transcript)
 - b. A copy of your Curriculum (required courses for your degree) from the Alcorn catalog.
3. Bring the application, the Banner transcript, and your curriculum course information to the Office of Global Programs to meet with Dr. Alipoe, Director of Office of Global Programs (call 6533 or email him to set up a time to meet). He will help you decide where you want to go, what university, and get your course work chosen and approved and start filling out additional paperwork related to Study Abroad.
