

Advising

Student success is a key component of the goal of Graduate Studies at Alcorn State University. Students admitted to a degree program are advised to contact their academic advisor or graduate coordinator to monitor progress in their program. Academic advisors help support academic attainment of students in their progression to degree completion. Each department has assigned graduate advisors according to degree programs who have been assigned by the department chair. If you are a new student or continuing student and are unsure who your advisor is, you have two options to put you in contact with your advisor.

1. Contact the department chair to inquire who the assigned advisor is.
2. Visit the graduate webpage 'Who Is My Advisor.'

Advisors act intentionally to support student success through various stages of the program and to make updates about degree completion requirements. This interaction is vital to students staying on track. Students are cautioned against self-advising. Advisors can be contacted via their office extension or email. Faculty contact information is available on each department's website.

Online students are strongly encouraged to maintain advisement collaborations with the designated academic advisor for accessibility to curriculum updates, resources, progression to degree completion requirements in the virtual environment.
