

NON DEGREE ENROLLMENT

A student admitted as non-degree is not formally accepted into a degree program at Alcorn State University. This admission status allows a student to enroll in a maximum number of nine course credits. Following, students must apply for a degree seeking program. Non-degree students reaching the maximum 9 hours will not be allowed to continue enrollment unless admitted to a degree seeking program. A HOLD is placed on the student's record to disallow future enrollment unless formally admitted to a degree seeking program.

Non degree students should carefully review their options based on their professional goals. Non degree seeking students are not eligible to receive financial aid. Students may petition the advisor of the degree seeking program to accept courses taken as a non-degree student.
