As we enter our Compliance Certification Cycle, it is important that we demonstrate to SACSCOC that all instruction delivered at the university is delivered by individuals with credentials that match closely with those courses that they teach. Therefore, all courses that have been taken above the B.S. degree will be entered and evaluated against courses offered by those respective instructors. Prepare to remain flexible as your course load may fluctuate as credentials are aligned with courses offered.

Accreditation is the life-giving blood of an academic institution, it is not the responsibility of one office or one person, but the entire institution. While it is the responsibility of the Office of the Provost to guide the university through this process, accountability extends from those who are responsible for maintaining safe work and study spaces to those teaching advanced courses.
