## **Assessment Data Uses**

Assessment data can be used in a variety of ways for continuous improvement. Assessment data can be used to:

- 1. change/update course content
- 2. add/delete courses or change course sequence
- 3. change degree requirements or degree sheet options
- 4. identify/justify new faculty positions
- 5. facilitate curriculum discussions at faculty meetings, curriculum committee meetings, and faculty retreats
- 6. guide changes in degree programs and development of new degree program options
- 7. justify past curriculum changes and to show program improvement resulting from those changes
- 8. change advisement processes
- 9. develop/revise academic services for students
- 10. develop/revise career services for students
- 11. change student academic facilities such as computer labs, science labs, and study areas
- 12. develop program-based websites to provide students with academic and program information
- 13. share assessment information with alumni and review boards
- 14. use assessment information to further refine the assessment methods or to implement new assessment methods

These assessment uses should not be considered exhaustive, but examples of assessment uses.
