CM 519 Practicum School Counseling Case Study Assessment Summary

The CM 519 Practicum School Counseling Case Study Assessment data from Summer 2022 and Summer 2023 indicates consistent and strong performance across all evaluated criteria, with overall mean scores of 2.70 and 2.67 respectively falling within the “Meets Standard” to “Exceeds Standard” range.

Candidates demonstrated solid abilities in identifying student issues, implementing strategies, and communicating their reasoning effectively. Notably, the reflection component showed improvement in 2023, achieving a perfect mean score of 3.00. However, due to low enrollment in the School Counselor track, no students were enrolled in CM 519A during Summer 2024, resulting in no available data for that term.
