



Mississippi Foundation of Reading Licensure Average Exam Summary

The 2023–2024 Mississippi Foundations of Reading exam data for the EPP indicates strong performance among the small group of test takers. All five candidates (100%) passed the exam, achieving a mean score of 253.2 and a median of 255.0, with score ranges between 235 and 241. These results are notably higher than the state mean of 237.1, based on 1,254 test-takers across Mississippi. This performance suggests that EPP candidates demonstrated a solid understanding of foundational reading concepts and were well-prepared for the exam.

The data also reflects the impact of the Mississippi Department of Education's COVID-related waiver, which suspended licensure testing requirements until December 2023. As a result, this is the first significant year of post-waiver data for the EPP, providing an important benchmark moving forward. Despite the small sample size, the high scores relative to state averages reinforce the quality of preparation offered by the EPP's reading instruction components and signal a positive outlook for future cohorts as testing resumes.

Note: The Alternate Route Program did not have any licensure exam data available due to the Mississippi Department of Education's COVID-related waiver.
