



## Praxis II Licensure Average Exam Summary

The Praxis II Licensure Exam data for EPP during the 2023–2024 academic year reveals a notable contrast between overall exam performance and performance by content subcategories. Specifically, for the Elementary Education (5017) exam, EPP candidates achieved a 100% pass rate with a mean score of 169.8, which surpasses both the state average of 160.24 and the national average of 161.58. This indicates that, on the whole, the small cohort of EPP completers (N=5) demonstrated strong overall performance and were well-prepared to meet licensure requirements.

However, a closer look at the subcategory data tells a different story. Across all five content areas Reading and Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Art/Music/Physical Education, the EPP candidates scored significantly lower in terms of average percentage correct compared to both state and national averages. For instance, in Reading and Language Arts, EPP candidates averaged 22% correct, compared to over 67% nationally and statewide. Similar disparities are evident in Mathematics (16.2% vs. 66–70%), Science (10.8% vs. 73–77%), and other areas. This suggests that while EPP candidates were able to pass the overall exam, their foundational knowledge in key content areas may be limited, pointing to a need for curricular improvements and additional content preparation.

Additionally, the EPP did not have any candidates take licensure exams in areas such as Biology, English, Mathematics, Music Education, Physical Education, and Social Studies. Only five candidates were required to take the licensure exams, as they were not admitted under the Mississippi Department of Education's COVID-related waiver. All other candidates were admitted under the waiver, which suspended licensure testing requirements through December 2023.
