ACADEMIC STANDARDS

The candidate must maintain a minimum standard of 3.0 on a 4.0 system. The student must not accumulate more than six semester hours of credit below B (3.0). Either of the above will result in the removal of the student from candidacy for the degree.

TIME LIMIT

All program requirements for graduate degrees, including transfer credits, must be completed within six years from the beginning of the first term in which credit was earned toward the degree.

OFFICE OF GRADUATE STUDIES

The central purpose of Graduate Studies is to provide advanced training of men and women, and the promotion of research that will contribute to knowledge in an atmosphere of freedom and inquiry. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

1. A complete application for admission.
2. An official transcript of all academic work on the college level.
3. Passing score on the Praxis C.A.S.E. and Praxis II (as appropriate for Master of Arts in Teaching).
4. Two letters (Recommendation Letter forms) of recommendation; Three letters are required for nursing applicants which must be on letterhead, bear a date, and live signature of the recommender).
5. Applicants to the Department of Graduate Nursing must submit a) evidence of licensure in Mississippi, b) evidence of malpractice or liability insurance with current identification number, c) a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing from an accredited nursing program, d) Resume', and e) a personal statement of professional goals of no more than 500 words.
6. For International students, the results of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or International English Language Testing System (IELTS) for students from non-English speaking countries, evidence of financial support, and an official course-by-course transcript evaluated by a member of National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES)., and Tuberculosis Screening (Chest X-Ray & Blood Test) after arrival in the United States.
7. Immunization Record: Two doses of the MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) vaccine. International students must also submit Tuberculosis Screening results for chest x-ray and blood test.
8. Application fee of forty dollars-Domestic student applicants (\$40.00) and sixty dollars (\$60.00) for International student applicants (payment made through Slate Application and payable to Alcorn State University) .
9. Additional admission may be required by departments according to degree requirements.
